

Rooms for hire at Hampstead Quaker Meeting House

120 Heath Street, Hampstead NW3 1DR

Rooms are available Monday to Saturday, between 9am and 10pm. On Sundays rooms may be available from time to time if hiring does not conflict with Quaker activity.



Main Meeting Room - a large and attractive, room on ground floor, carpeted, with wood panelling. 10.3m X 9.8m. Loop system. Suspended spherical lights. Seating capacity 120.

Weekdays: £36.50 an hour (non-regular users), £30 (regular, four or more bookings a year)

Weekends: £50 an hour (non-regular users), £42 (regular, four or more bookings a year)



Downstairs Meeting Room - downstairs, parquet floor. 7.6m x 4.1m overhead lighting. Seating capacity 25 – 30.

Weekdays £19.00 per hour; Weekends £19.50 per hour



Library - upstairs, carpeted, 5.5m X 3.8m.
Ideal for smaller group meetings of up to 20.
Lovely character filled room.
Weekdays: £23.50 an hour (non-regular users),
£23.50 (regular, four or more bookings a year)

Weekends: £26 per hour (non-regular users),
£23.50 (regular, four or more bookings a year)



Elders' Room - downstairs, tiled floor with rug. Comfortable sofa and chairs. 5m X10.3m.
Cozy and quiet. Ideal for one-to-one counselling.

Any day £14.50 per hour

General Information

Users are normally allowed 15 minutes setting up time and 15 minutes clearing up time.

All day use: 8 hours for the price of 7

A regular user is a group or individual who uses the room at least 4 times a year.

Tea Point - available in the foyer on the ground floor.



Kitchen – downstairs, fully fitted, cooker, refrigerator, saucepans, utensils, crockery and cutlery.

Disabilities: access is available to the ground floor (main meeting room and foyer only by a portable ramp). There is a toilet for people with disabilities on the ground floor. The main meeting room has a loop system.

Location: The Meeting House is 200 meters from Hampstead Heath and many beautiful walks. It is also situated within easy reach of an interesting variety of restaurants, coffee shops and boutiques. ([map](#))

Public Transport: Hampstead Tube Station (Northern line, Edgware branch). Buses 210 or 268 to Whitestone Pond or 46 to Hampstead High Street.

Parking: Pay and display parking is available behind Jack Straw's Castle (a few minutes walk) and opposite the Meeting House. Parking after 6pm is free in pay and display bays; after 8pm in Residents' parking bays.
